God's Word is important to us

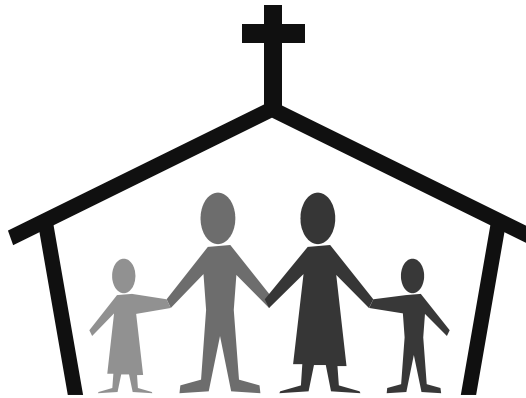
God's word (the Bible) is the basis for all our teaching, standards and decisions.
